This week we had a **new automated siren** installed at the school. This was installed on Wednesday and operated for the first time on Thursday. Instead of the siren we have a chime that can be heard in every classroom as well as throughout all playground areas. While the new siren was being installed we also had speakers placed around the school so any and all messages can be heard if students and staff are outside of their classrooms. Hopefully there will not be any more teething problems.

Soon the **City of Stirling will be pruning some trees** near the school's fence line. Some of the branches are over-hanging the fence, buildings and or play areas. This poses a potential risk (although remote) so the City of Stirling is cleaning this up. We will also have some pruning done on the large Tuart tree out the front of our staffroom and near Room 17 (Mrs Smith's demountable). This has been inspected and although it looks very unwell it is actually structurally sound. The dying of the leaves is actually being caused by bugs laying their eggs. The gardeners will place some repellent during the holidays and hopefully this will improve the tree.

Soon there will be **internal fencing placed around the farm**. This will enable the Pre-Primary students to use this area as part of their learning program and during their recess and lunch breaks. The gates within this fencing will be self-closing but will be kept open until 9:15am and after 2:30pm (the same as the main gates). Although the farm will be used predominately by the Pre-Primary and Kindy classes it will still be available to all classes throughout the school. There are a few students who enjoy going into the farm during recess and lunch and they will still be permitted to do so.

Currently we are looking at our **school's newsletter**, its format and the information that it contains. The newsletter is one of the main vehicles for dissemination of information to our parents. Because of this we would like parents to provide us with some information relating to what you would like contained in the newsletter, how often it is sent out, its overall purpose (e.g. providing information relating to how to help your child learn, tips for homework/English/Math etc. etc.) and what you currently like/don't like. There is a small slip that parents can return to the school over the next couple of weeks.
