We will be rotating the Yr. 3/Yr. 4 students and Yr. 5/Yr. 6 students through the area each day (e.g. Yr. 3/4 recess – Yr. 5/6 lunch on day 1; Yr. 5/6 recess – Yr. 3/4 lunch on day 2, etc.).
