



## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I would like to welcome all our new and current students and families to Term 3. Once again we are in for a very productive but busy term. There are many important dates already on the school Term Planner that is accessible via our website. Some dates that parents need to be aware of are; School Development Day on **August 25<sup>th</sup>** (students are not at school); Parent-Teacher Interviews on **August 29<sup>th</sup>** (a note about this is with this newsletter and contains information about the school closing at 12:20pm); Faction Athletics Carnival on **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August** and Friday **September 1<sup>st</sup>** and Interschool Athletics Carnival on Wednesday **13<sup>th</sup> September** and Friday **15<sup>th</sup> September**.

**Parent – Teacher interviews** will be held on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August from 1pm. Parents need to indicate possible timeslots that they can attend on the note attached to this newsletter. For students in Years 4 – 6, three-way interviews will be held. This means that the student will sit in the meeting with the parent and teacher. For students in Kindy – Yr. 3 the meetings will be just for the parent and teacher. Each interview will be 10 minutes. If you need to bring your child during your interview (K – 3) there will be an area where your child can wait with a supervising teacher. Students will not be allowed to run around the school or use the play equipment. Please be aware that the school closes at 12:20pm and students are required to either be picked up or make their way home.

Our staff in the front office are continually trying to keep contact details for students as accurate and up to date as possible. Many parents have been very proactive in providing correct or updated home and mobile phone numbers. It is also important that we have **correct email details for families**. If you have not provided your email to the school or if it has changed please contact the front office. Currently as a school we are investigating sending student reports home electronically in the future. For this to occur we need accurate email details for all parent contacts.

### **Mathletics**

Mathletics is available to you and your children at home. Mathletics is a fun, interactive Maths program that is directly linked to the West Australian Curriculum. Mathletics is an online numeracy resource, helping students to love learning and achieve greater results through engaging content that perfectly matches their school curriculum and it improves the student's skills and results.

Children engage in many worthwhile Maths activities at school, under the teacher's guidance and the children can access Mathletics outside school hours, through the individual password that has been allocated to your child.

Here are some ideas to help your child get the most out of Mathletics. Encourage your child to:

- \* Log on independently.
- \* Click on the 'question' (if they are unable to read the question) and a recording will repeat the question.
- \* Use the 'question mark' on the left for further information if they are unsure of what do.
- \* Review mistakes by clicking on them and working out where they went wrong.
- \* Redo activities where they got a red or blue rating and 'Go for gold!'

Please use the valuable resource. If you have any questions, please talk to your child's teacher.

## Parent – Teacher Interviews 29<sup>th</sup> August

Deanmore Primary School will be holding parent–teacher interviews on Tuesday August 29<sup>th</sup> from 1pm – 5:30pm. **The school will close at 12:20pm and students will need to be collected or make their way home.**

For parents of Kindergarten to Year 3 students the meetings will be for parents and teachers only, no students will be present. For parents of Year 4 to 6 students the meetings will be “three way” with parents, teachers and the student present.

Attached is a note for parents to return by Monday August 14<sup>th</sup>. Please indicate a time frame (1pm – 3pm or 3pm – 5:30pm) for an interview. Interviews will only be 10 minutes with a few minutes for parents and staff to transition for the next interview. For the small minority of parents who are unable to make any of these times there will be the opportunity to arrange an interview at a later date with the teacher.

During a parent’s interview, some staff will be available to supervise students if they are required to come with their parents. Students can be dropped off at the library just before the interview and collected straight after.

This is a great opportunity for parents to meet one on one with teachers to discuss how their child has progressed since the Term 2 report was written. These interviews were a request brought up at the school board and as a response to parent feedback in various school community surveys. The time for the adjustment to the school day has been endorsed by the school board. The intent of notifying the school community 5 to 6 weeks in advance is to allow the school to create interview slots and provide parents with sufficient time to organise supervision of their children. Interview times will be available to parents at the beginning of Week 6.
