PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

School Board voting – We would like to thank those parents who have already taken the opportunity to fill in a voting slip for new School Board members starting in 2018. Every family is entitled to vote once. If you have not yet had the chance to do so please feel free to come to our front office to get a voting slip and place it in the sealed box. Voting closes next Wednesday (1st November).

I would like to congratulate Mrs Melinda Carr on her success on being accepted into the **STEM X Academy** in Canberra during the upcoming January school holidays. This is a 5 day residential professional learning program designed to help teachers acquire the skills and confidence to design, develop and implement STEM based teaching resources and lessons. Making this even more meritorious is that Mrs Carr is one of only 70 teachers from across Australia to be accepted into the program. Nearly the entire costs are covered by a federal government grant. We all look forward to hearing and seeing what she learns over those 5 days.

Mrs Carr has also been successful in gaining a **Maker Projects** grant through the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science. Maker Projects is an element of the Inspiring Australia – Science Engagement Programme that was announced as part of the Inspiring All Australians in Digital Literacy and Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) element of the National Innovation and Science Agenda (NISA). The objective of the Maker Projects element is to encourage practical skills, creativity and entrepreneurial thinking through the development of maker spaces and activities in schools and communities, with the view to reaching as many students as possible. This \$5000 grant will enable the school to purchase two Apple Mac Pro Laptops, PAL filament and ABS filament for use with our 3D printers.

SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2018

The Western Australian Government's priority is to ensure that all students are entitled to participate in an educational program that satisfies the requirements of the *Western Australian Curriculum and Assessment Outline*.

The School Contributions and Charges financial procedure guides parents and carers to understand the flexibilities of school fee structures and to determine the estimated total cost of their child's education. It is a requirement of the Education Act that all possible contributions and charges are identified two months prior to the beginning of the school year.

The Deanmore Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for 2018.

1. CONTRIBUTIONS

The term relates to the monies requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by K-6 students in the standard educational program which Deanmore PS is required to provide.

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay for Kindergarten to Year 6 is \$60.00.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas such as materials for art and craft, design and technology and science, photocopy materials, classroom materials, web based curriculum materials/resources. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of the teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution.

2. CHARGES

These are amounts paid for participation in separate events; sporting activities, incursions, excursions, swimming lessons, dance etc. We hope that all children will attend these activities but only those who pay will attend.

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in incursions, excursions and activities for 2018 has been included on the attached schedule. These charges reflect similar charges that have been made over previous years. Students will only incur cost when they are involved in a particular activity. The amount on the schedule represents the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2018. You will be asked to make payment to the school for each activity as it approaches.

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities made available to *all* students, but conditional on a payment being made eg. incursions, excursions.
- Specific learning activities made available to *selected* students, but conditional on payment being made, eg School of Instrumental Music program etc.
