Reporting to Parents

Electronic Delivery of Reports Semester 2

This semester, Deanmore Primary School will be delivering your child's Semester 2 report electronically via email and not as a printed copy as in the past.

The electronic report provides advantages for schools and the parent community including:

- timely delivery of reports to parents and guardians;
- school savings in the printing and collation of reports;
- an ability to easily provide copies of reports to each parent or guardian where dictated by family circumstances;
- reports not being lost on the way home; and
- Parents being able to retain a digital record of student achievement.

Very few parents in the school do not have an email address. However, it is imperative that you ensure your email address is correct with the school for the purposes of receiving your child/children's reports.

We have also asked that for the purpose of different family circumstances, anyone requesting a copy of the report be sent to a second family member to inform the school in writing via Deanmore.ps@education.wa.edu.au as soon as possible.

SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2018

The Western Australian Government's priority is to ensure that all students are entitled to participate in an educational program that satisfies the requirements of the Western Australian Curriculum and Assessment Outline.

The School Contributions and Charges financial procedure guides parents and carers to understand the flexibilities of school fee structures and to determine the estimated total cost of their child's education. It is a requirement of the Education Act that all possible contributions and charges are identified two months prior to the beginning of the school year.

The Deanmore Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for 2018.

1. CONTRIBUTIONS

The term relates to the monies requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by K-6 students in the standard educational program which Deanmore PS is required to provide.

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay for Kindergarten to Year 6 is \$60.00.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas such as materials for art and craft, design and technology and science, photocopy materials, classroom materials, web based curriculum materials/resources. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of the teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution.

CHARGES

These are amounts paid for participation in separate events; sporting activities, incursions, excursions, swimming lessons, dance etc. We hope that all children will attend these activities but only those who pay will attend.

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in incursions, excursions and activities for 2018 has been included on the attached schedule. These charges reflect similar charges that have been made over previous years. Students will only incur cost when they are involved in a particular activity. The amount on the schedule represents the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2018. You will be asked to make payment to the school for each activity as it approaches.

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities made available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made eg.
 incursions, excursions.
- Specific learning activities made available to selected students, but conditional on payment being made, eg School of Instrumental Music program etc.
