Those parents who attended found the opportunity valuable as it built their understanding of the importance the various components of an explicit lesson has in scaffolding, supporting and extending the learning of all students of varying abilities. The parents are now more familiar with the language that students are using at school, which will put them in a better position to talk about their child's learning.

Bethany is a caring and friendly psychologist who works with both children and adolescents experiencing a range of psychological issues, including, but not limited to:

- adjustment difficulties (social or situational)
- anxiety (social or school/test stress)
- mood and emotional concerns
- stress from family situations
- behavioural concerns and self-harm
- interpersonal challenges
- Autism Spectrum
- learning difficulties

Each child is supported respectfully and uniquely. To achieve positive and best outcomes, Bethany utilises psychological techniques such as Cognitive Behavioural Therapy and Solution-Focused Therapy, along with psychoeducation.

We are sincerely grateful to have this service available within our school community and if you believe that it might benefit your child, please contact me for further instructions.




The P&C would like to say a HUGE thank you to all our volunteers who helped make the movie night such a great success.
