PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

NAPLAN has come and gone for another year. For those children and families who experienced these assessments for the first time now know that it isn't as stressful as some may have believed. What was pleasing was the effort that each and every child made over the week. All that we asked was that they tried their best and gave every question a go. The school will receive NAPLAN data and individual reports later in Term 3. Individual child reports will be sent home to parents as soon as we receive them.

SEMESTER 1 STUDENT REPORTS

Student reports (Pre-Primary to Year 6) will be sent home electronically once again. It is important that parent and carer email details are up to date to ensure that reports will be received. When your child's report arrives, the link provided is only live for 2 weeks. You will need to download the report within that 2 week time frame. If you are unsure whether your email details are correct please contact our front office staff.

BIENNIAL PARENT SURVEYS

Every two (2) years Government schools are required to survey their parent community. Currently the School, in consultation with the School Board, is developing the 2018 parent survey. These will be made "live" during Term 3. In 2016, 47 parents completed the online, anonymous survey. This year we would like a minimum of 100 parents complete the survey. This will ensure that we capture the views of a large proportion of our parent body. We will notify parents when the surveys open and close at a later date.

JOIN US FOR PIRATE DAY FRIDAY AND SUPPORT CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH!

Friday, 8 June is the official date for Pirate Day Friday 2018 and children, parents and staff are invited to come to school dressed in your swashbuckling best, bringing your pirate treasure (gold coin donation).


Every dollar raised through Pirate Day Friday is allocated to scientific studies focused on childhood brain cancer through The Adventurers in Western Australia and The Kids' Cancer Project in all other Australian states and territories.

In 2018, money raised by pirates in Western Australia will go to the **Telethon Kids Institute Cancer Centre Brain Tumour Research Program**. Funds generated by pirates in all other Australian states and territories will help fund a study lead by **Dr Bryan Day at QIMR Berghofer Medical Research Institute with the objective of developing personalised medicine to treat medulloblastoma**, a fast-growing, high-grade brain tumour which most commonly affects children but can affect adults too.
