SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS Wednesday 22nd & Thursday 23rd August 2018

MSP Photography will complete our school photos on Wednesday 22nd and Thursday 23rd August.

Class photos will commence at 9:00am on both days in the undercover area. If a student is away or late on the day of their class photo these photos can't be taken again.

Individual student photos will be taken in the library. Depending on the weather the Kindy and Pre-primary photos will either be taken in the undercover area or in one of our playgrounds.

All students must wear the required school uniform for their photos. Our Year 6 students must wear their leavers shirts.

A draft timetable is attached for parents, however be aware that this may change closer to the date or on the day.

There is an option for family photos however the school does not create a timetable for this.

Family photos will be taken in the library on Wednesday and Thursday from 8:00am – 8:50am, at recess (10:50am – 11:10am) and lunch (12:40pm – 1:20pm). Students cannot be taken out of class during lesson times for family photos.

All photos will need to be ordered and paid for online this year through the MSP website. An information package has been distributed to families. Each student will have a form with their name and a code on it. It is important that parents read the instructions for ordering and payment.

There is a catch-up time slot for individual photos on Thursday 23rd August. If there are any students who are away on both days, parents will need to contact MSP to have individual or graduation photos taken. These catch-up photos are taken at the MSP studios and are organised by parents.

PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Deanmore Primary School will be holding parent-teacher interviews on Wednesday 5th September from 1:20pm - 6:00pm. The school will close at 12:40pm and students will need to be collected or make their way home. For parents of Kindergarten to Year 3 students the meetings will be for parents and teachers only, no students will be present. For parents of Year 4 to 6 students the meetings will be "three way" with parents, teachers and the student present. Attached is a note for parents to return by Friday August 3rd. Please indicate a time frame (1:20pm - 3:00pm or 3:15pm – 5:50pm) for an interview, all your children's names and the rooms that they are in. Please return the completed form to the specially marked box outside the office. Interviews will only be 10 minutes long with a few minutes for parents and staff to transition for the next interview. During a parent's interview, some staff will be available to supervise **students** if they are required to come with their parents. Students only can be dropped off at the library or ECE wet area just before the interview and collected straight after. They will not be permitted to be in the playground. This is a great opportunity for parents to meet one on one with teachers to discuss how their child has progressed since the Term 2 report was written. These interviews were a request brought up at the school board and as a response to parent feedback in various school community surveys. The time for the adjustment to the school day has been endorsed by the school board. The intent of notifying the school community 7 to 8 weeks in advance is to allow the school to create interview slots and provide parents with sufficient time to organise supervision of their children. Interview times will be available to parents at the beginning of Week 6.
