PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I would like to thank those parents who have taken the opportunity to provide feedback on the new logo concepts. You have until August 24 to provide feedback. The concepts around the school are for people to consider a logo design and not a new shirt. The shirt on the concepts is just a rendering for illustration purposes. In the School Parent Survey that opens in Week 6 there are questions about the current school uniform for parents to answer.

Last week we sent off about 15kg of used coffee pods to Nespresso for recycling. Below is a small article from the weekend paper that shows an item that is partially made from recycled aluminium. The coffee grounds are separated and sent to industrial composting facilities. This is a great initiative that the school and community are taking up.

There are some requirements that Nespresso asks us to follow when pods are placed in the recycling boxes. They need to be dry and as clean as possible. They cannot be in other plastic bags or wrapping (e.g. small plastic lunch bags) and only aluminium pods can be dropped off. If you are able to follow these simple requests when you drop off your pods at the school it would be greatly appreciated. Recycling boxes can be found at our Kindy and Library.

Parents may have recently heard or read about a privacy issue concerning students at some private high-schools in Perth, specifically the use of Instagram. Although a vast majority of our students should not be using Instagram or Facebook, let alone without parent supervision, the reality is that some are. It is important that parents are aware of what their child is viewing or sending on these social media platforms. I have not heard of any children at Deanmore PS having any particular issue but it is an opportune time for parents to discuss with their child appropriate safety and confidentiality when using social media.

Currently there is still a large amount of clothing in the lost property box outside of the Science room. Many children are bringing their jumpers to school and then leaving around the grounds. We remind the children almost daily to check for their clothes; however the pile does not appear to be getting any smaller. If your child is missing clothing please tell them to check the lost property.

We are beginning to start class planning for 2019. If your child is not returning in 2018 (not including children finishing Year 6), could you please notify the front office (via a phone call, note or email) which school they will be moving to.

The Parent Survey will be available online from Monday 20 August.

In 2018 we are aiming to have a minimum of 100 responses (we only had 47 in 2016) to ensure we have the views of a wide cross section of our parent body. Questions within the survey will ask for your views on a 1 to 1 parent supplied device program, the school uniform, the ERG process, current teaching programs, homework, sustainability, organisation of parent information sessions and the school board. The survey will close on Friday 5 October.

PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Deanmore Primary School will be holding parent-teacher interviews on **Wednesday 5th September from 1:20pm – 6:00pm. The school will close at 12:40pm** and students will need to be collected or make their way home. For parents of Kindergarten to Year 3 students the meetings will be for parents and teachers only, no students will be present. For parents of Year 4 to 6 students the meetings will be “three way” with parents, teachers and the student present. Attached is a note for parents to return to the labelled collection box. Please indicate a time frame (1:20pm – 3:00pm or 3:15pm – 5:50pm) for an interview, all your children’s names and the rooms that they are in. Please return the completed form to the specially marked box outside the office. Interviews will only be 10 minutes long with a few minutes for parents and staff to transition for the next interview. During a parent’s interview, some staff will be available to supervise **students** if they are required to come with their parents. Students only can be dropped off at the library or ECE wet area just before the interview and collected straight after. They will not be permitted to be in the playground. This is a great opportunity for parents to meet one on one with teachers to discuss how their child has progressed since the Term 2 report was written. These interviews were a request brought up at the school board and as a response to parent feedback in various school community surveys. The time for the adjustment to the school day has been endorsed by the school board. The intent of notifying the school community 7 to 8 weeks in advance is to allow the school to create interview slots and provide parents with sufficient time to organise supervision of their children. Interview times will be available to parents at the beginning of Week 6.

COMMUNITY SCHOOL HEALTH NURSE

The following information has been approved by the Health Department to promote health in our school.

COLDS

Upper respiratory tract infections or colds are everywhere, especially in winter, so it is almost impossible to stop children from catching them. Here are some points which may help:

- Teach your child to cover his/her nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing, and to wash hands straight afterwards.
- Hands should be washed after blowing noses and before eating.
- Use tissues once and then throw them in the bin. (Avoid using handkerchiefs).
- Keep your child home from school if he/she has a cold/cough/fever/pain.
- Make sure that your children eat a balanced diet of plenty of healthy foods.
- Keep children away from smoke—it irritates their eyes and nasal passages, making it more likely that they will catch a cold.

WHAT DO YOU DO IF YOUR CHILD GETS A COLD

No treatment will cure a cold or make it go away more quickly, but you can help your child feel more comfortable:

- Rest: This need not be in bed.
- Provide extra drinks: If your child doesn't want to drink much, try giving lots of small sips of water, milk or juice, or ice blocks to such for older children.

HAND WASHING

Washing hands is the easiest way to protect ourselves from contagious diseases, like colds, influenza and gastroenteritis. Hands should be washed before and after eating or preparing food, after going to the toilet and after nose blowing.

- When teaching your child to wash their hands:
- Use clean water and soap, making sure they cover their hands and wrists.
- Use a brush to clean under nails if they're dirty too.
- Dry their hands with something clean (like a paper towel).

Alcohol based sanitisers are useful when soap and water is not available. Use half a teaspoon of the product and encourage your child to rub their hands together until they're dry. If you can see dirt on their hands, it is better to use soap and water.
