Last Thursday, Mr Rodgers was in Melbourne as a guest of the Australian Cricket Board for the work he has been doing with cricket, and specifically girls cricket. It would have been a very proud moment for him when he was officially named the runner-up 2019 School Community Ambassador of the year. 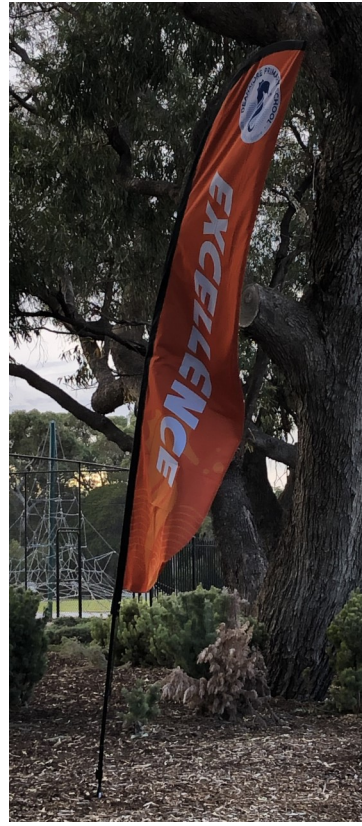
I hope everyone has a relaxing and refreshing long weekend.
