PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Semester One student reports will be emailed to parents on Tuesday (2nd July) of the last week of this term. This report summarises your child's achievement, attitude, behaviour and effort. Learning area achievement indicates how your child is developing their knowledge, skills, understanding and values as outlined in the Western Australian Curriculum. Overall learning grades may change from year to year, and semester to semester, and previous achievement does not influence future achievement. It is not uncommon for students to move up or down on the achievement scale. As students progress through school years the knowledge and skills they are required to master become more difficult.

A learning area achievement of "C" for Year 3 – 6 students and "Satisfactory" for Pre-primary to Year 2 students indicates a child is demonstrating satisfactory achievement of what is expected for their year level at that time. Any achievement of "D" or "Limited" and below indicates that your child is not achieving the expected standard. It is important that as a parent you read the comments from the classroom teacher as these outline what you child can do and where they can improve. If you are unsure about anything contained in your child's report it is important that you organise a meeting with their teacher.

Reports are emailed directly to the email address you have provided to the school. If your email address has changed, or if you are not sure we have the current one, it is important that you contact our front office staff. When you receive the reports via email you need to open and download/save the report within 2 weeks. After this period, you will not be able to access the email or report.

School staff do a very good job at tracking which children need to have reports sent to more than one email address due to family situations or separation. However, as a school we are not always informed if sending a report to more than one email address or parent is required. If you need to have your child's report sent to more than one email address and have not informed the school or unsure if the information we have is accurate, please contact our front office staff.

There will be an ArtMarket meeting on Wednesday the 19th of June 7.30pm at the Scarborough Sportsmen's Club.




News from Janina, Jenny and Barbs in the Canteen


