At school attendance, student movements and safety

Student learning and school attendance are closely linked, and here at Deanmore PS we say that "Every Day Counts". This is particularly true for students who are strong learners, as their learning can be MOST affected by extended times away from school. I am passionate about attendance and I will be talking more with families and the school community over the coming weeks.

Our procedures here at school are to check and record attendance BY 9AM each day, with the office staff following up with families about students being away. We are tightening our procedures in classrooms to make sure that we have EVERY child checked by 9 am, with follow up checks from admin if we are not sure about a student.

Please help us by:

- Bringing your child through the office if you bring them late to a morning assembly or other activity (ie after the bell)
- Coming through the front office if you need to take your child home after a morning activity such as an assembly

Reminding your child to come to the office and grab a late note, particularly if they arrive at a break time

Thankyou for your help in this matter – your child's safety is our first priority, and we can only be vigilant about their whereabouts if we know exactly where they are supposed to be!

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DEPUTY PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

SUN AWARE POLICY

The school, in consultation with the School Board, has developed a 'Sun Aware Policy' to ensure that our students take the necessary steps to protect themselves from skin damage from the sun. Whilst there is a strong focus during the hotter months of the year, the outlined strategies will be employed throughout the entire school year and will apply to all school activities, including excursions offsite.

In summary, the main areas of the policy are:

- all students, as part of the Dress Code policy, are to wear a broad-brimmed, bucket or legionnaire hat when outside,
- students not wearing the appropriate hat will be directed to play in an area protected from the sun,
- when the UV index is above '3,' students will eat their lunch in the undercover area and will be encouraged to play in shaded areas during break times,
- the school will provide students with access to SPF 30+ broad-spectrum, water-resistant sunscreen,
- All staff, parents and guests will be encouraged to be positive role models by demonstrating sun protective behaviours, such as wearing broad-brimmed, bucket or legionnaire hats when outside.

The Sun Aware Policy has been distributed to all parents via ClassDojo and has been posted on the school's website. Please contact the front office if you would like a hard copy of the policy or if you have any questions.
